Gathered Worship Service Information Sheet

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Before Arriving at Church:

+Sign-up for a service - Our service space will be limited at both campuses. Please be sure you sign up for a service time by visiting the [website](#) or calling the office (760-739-1650).

PLEASE NOTE: Our early service times are designated for people over the age of 65. This does not mean people over 65 are not able to attend other services, just that these services will be set aside especially for them. We encourage those under 65 to choose another service time if possible.

+Items to Bring-

-Hand Sanitizer - Please bring your own hand sanitizer. Though we will have hand sanitizer available, our supply is limited.

-Face Mask - We will require everyone to wear a facemask during the service except when taking communion.

+Check Your Health - If you have underlying health issues, are experiencing a fever, cough, sore throat, unexplained muscle aches, a runny or stuffy nose, or have lost the sense of taste or smell, we are asking that you **please stay home**. Also, if you have been exposed to anyone with the virus or have traveled someplace with an active virus spread, **please stay home**. Pastor Bob and Pastor Matt will be happy to talk with you about alternative ways of ministering to you through this time.

Upon Arriving at Church:

+Service Locations - Both Escondido and San Marcos campuses are now indoors for a limited number of worshippers. Please be sure you sign up for a service time by visiting the [website](#) or calling the office (760-739-1650).

+Entrance/Exit - The entrances and exits will be marked. Please follow the arrows laid out for you on the ground.

+Usher Station - You will be greeted at the entrance to the service by one of our volunteer ushers. They will ask you the four following questions:

1. Have you had or do you have a fever of 100 degrees or more in the last 24 hours?
2. Do you live with some who is showing symptoms of exposure to the infection or of a respiratory disease—including a temperature over 100 degrees, cough, body aches, shortness of breath?
3. Are you living with or have you recently visited with a family member who has been tested for COVID-19 and is waiting for results?
4. In the last 21 days, have you lived with or visited with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

***If you answer yes to these questions, we will ask you to go home and the pastor will call you later in the day to discuss ways he can minister to you through this time.**

+**Seating** - Seating will be available following guidelines set by the State of California and the County of San Diego. NOTE: Families will be able to sit together.

+**Childcare** - We will NOT be able to offer childcare at this time nor will we be able to offer busy bags.

+**Bulletin** - You will receive a bulletin with the order of service printed out for you. Please take that home with you. We will not be reusing them.

+**Restrooms** - Restrooms will be clearly marked. One person will be permitted in the restroom at a time.

During the Service:

+**Singing and Reading** - Our service times will be focused primarily on hearing the Word and receiving the sacrament. We will have very limited amounts of music and responsive readings.

+**Communion** - Instructions for how to attend the sacrament will be spelled out for you at the beginning of the service. Please be aware that social distancing will be respected during the service of the sacrament.

Leaving the Service:

+**Exit** - Please follow the designated exit arrows.

+**Offering** - The offering will be collected near the exit at the end of the service.
